come an adult, and now I am wishing for just a few more sleepless nights with my best friends, and a

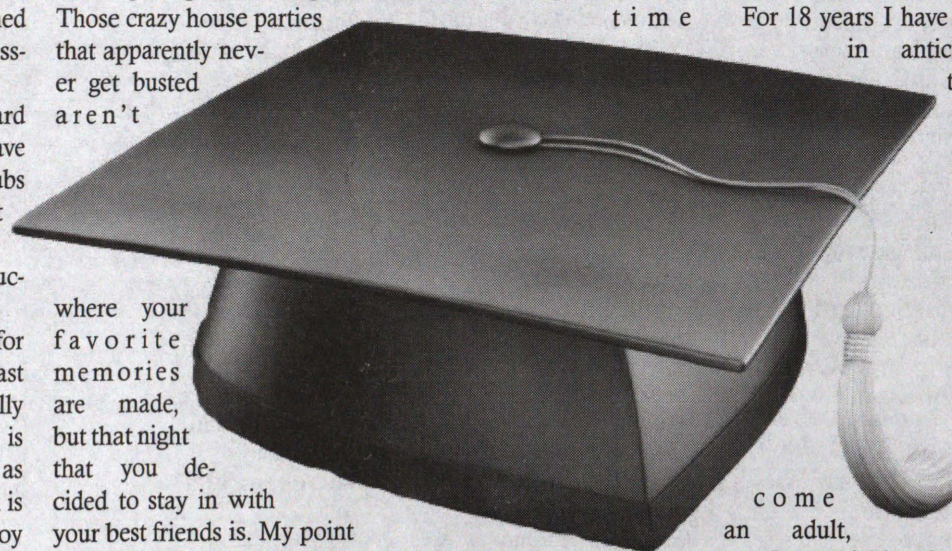
few more movie nights with my family. My trip to Spain, deadline hours, prom, bonfires, and girls' night will forever stay in my memory.
