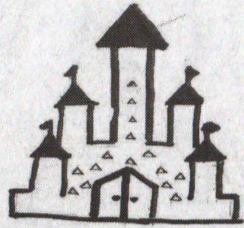
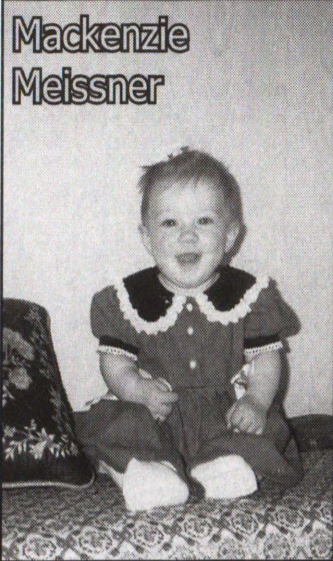

From kindergarten to high school, seniors have started to write their own stories, beginning with their childhood.



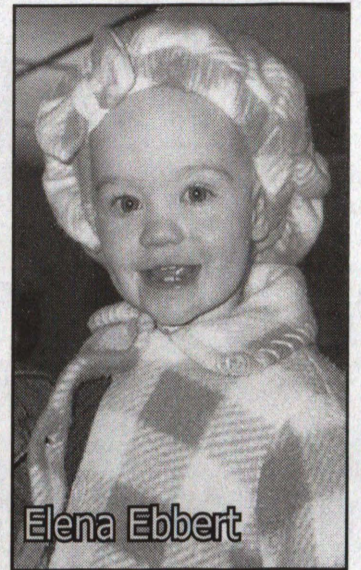

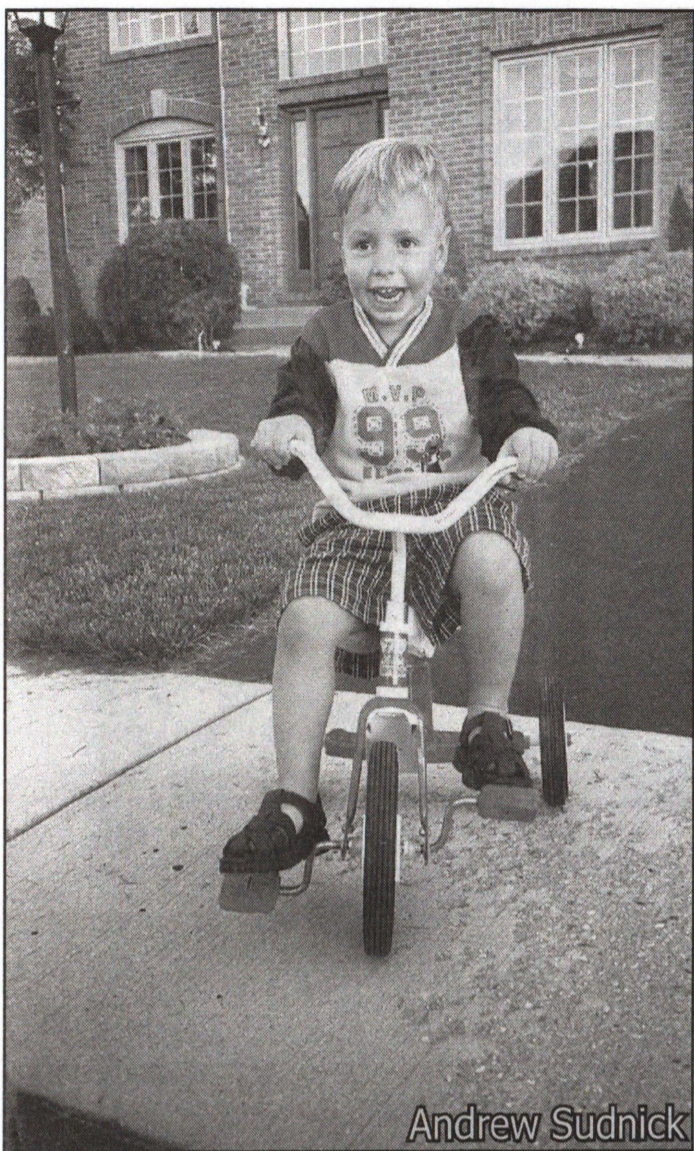

Go now and be strong, be courageous and make your mark on the world!

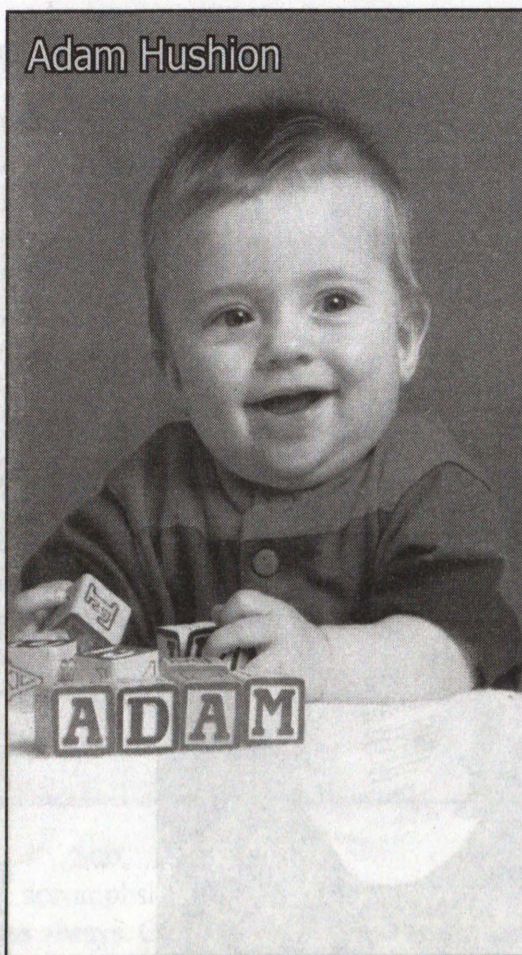
