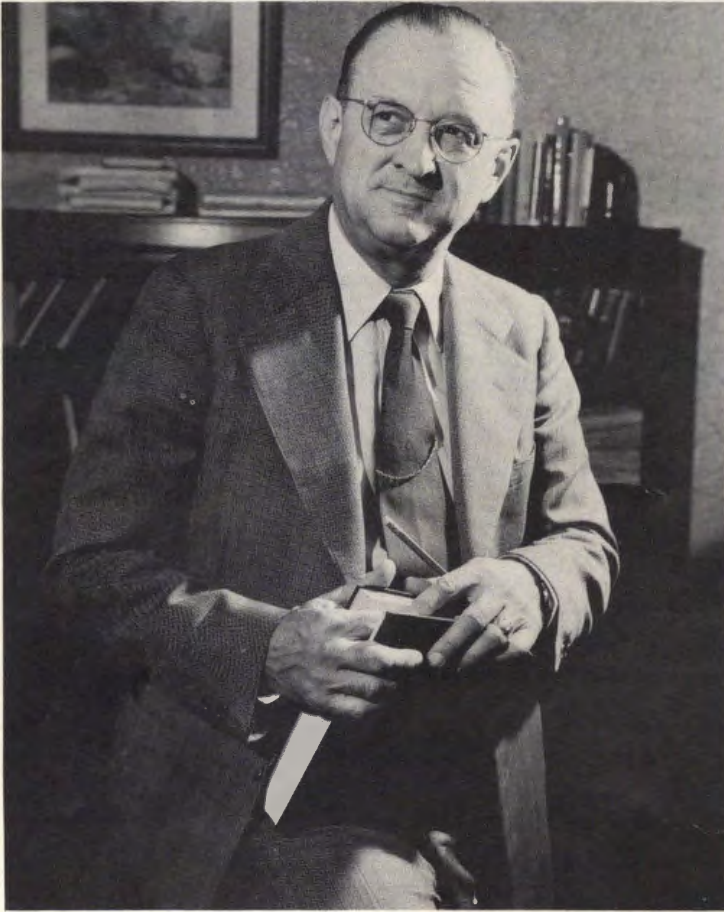

'Twas early in September of 1951 that the members of the class of '55 first entered the hallowed halls of W. C. C. H. S. In December we elected Jerry Olson, Ken Jahns, Margo Olesen, and Bruce Diershaw to govern our class business for the remainder of the year. We closed our first year of adventure with a trip to the Merchandise Mart and Lincoln Park.

Our sophomore year included two important firsts for us. It was the first of our three remaining years during which we received the guidance of Miss Mahoney as our class adviser. Also we gave our first all-school party "Christmas Capers." Mickey Johnson, elected treasurer, was our only new class officer. Our spring trip was a class outing at Brookfield Zoo.

"Cornshock Capers" started off our busy junior year. It became famous because of the Dragnet skit. Jerry Olson, Ken Haag, Margo Olesen, and Donna Moore had been elected the previous spring to manage class business. On April 9, "Stranger In The Night," our classplay, drew a packed house. The class trip took us to the steel mills and some 40 juniors also took the trip to Washington, D. C. On May 29, we ended our year with "Starlight Serenade," our Junior Prom, one of our fondest memories.

We were seniors now and for the fourth time Jerry Olson was our class president and Margo Olesen was our secretary. Wally Towne and Donna Moore were our other class officers. This was our school's 50th birthday; and we started it off with the birthday cake float in the homecoming parade. All year everyone was kept busy either preparing the Challenge or We-Go, making the varsity team, preparing for college, or taking part in some other important activity. "55" was the first year we had a baseball team at We-Go. Memories of our four years and news of a new school filled our minds all the way through until Senior Week was over.

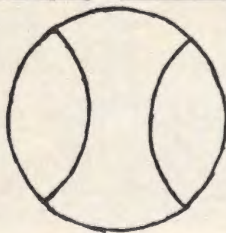

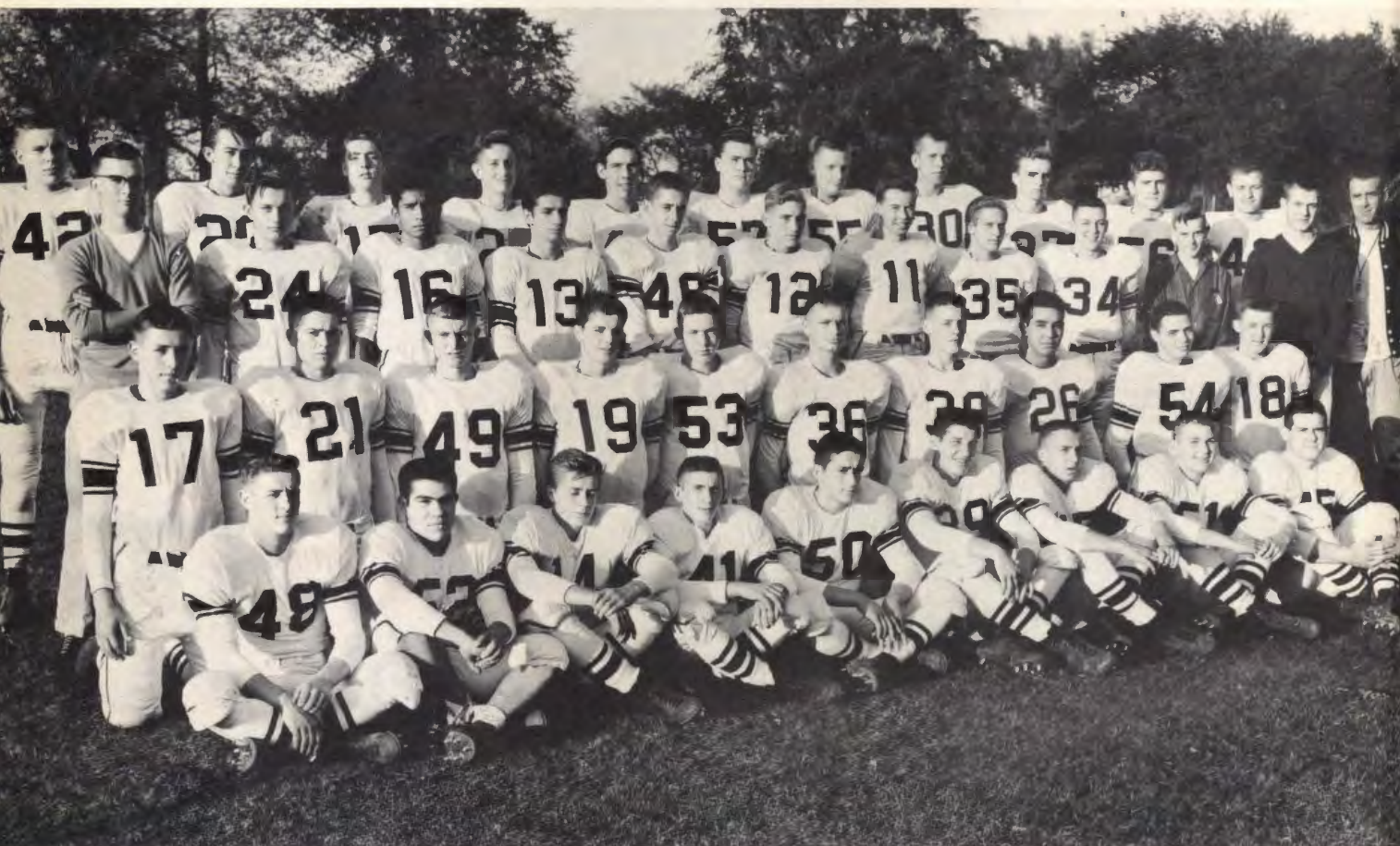
