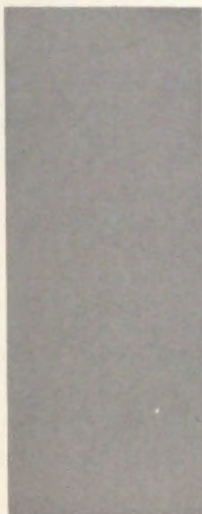


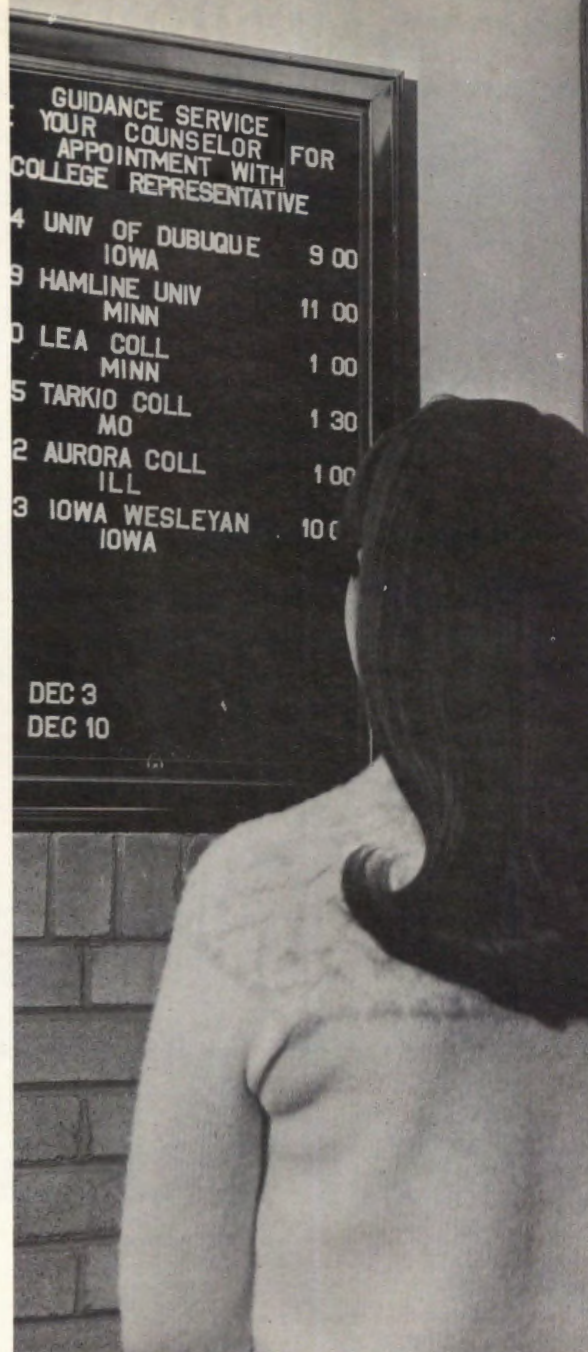
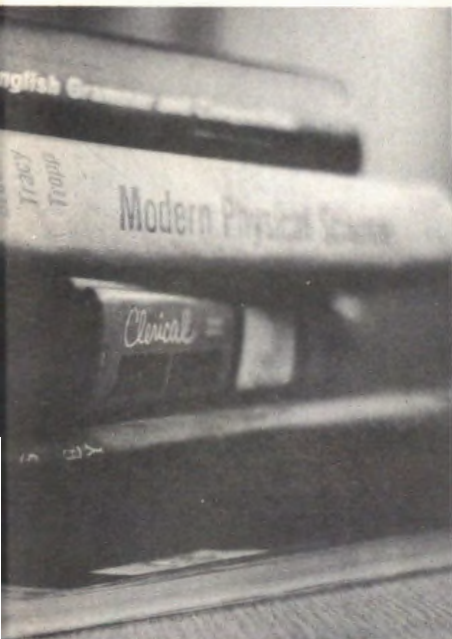

Our Interrelated Cooperative Training program is in its second successful year of operation. This course in diverse vocational training is available to selective juniors and seniors.

While employed on an alternating half-day basis, students receive some remuneration, and at the same time they are learning and practicing the skills of an occupation. During school time the I. C. T. student takes prescribed courses which are related to the occupation for which he is being trained.

The program has an enrollment of ten boys and six girls. The occupations that they are training for are the following: a Wheaton newspaper sports editor, office manager, stenographer, warehouse man, clerk-typist, auto-mechanic, file clerk, meat cutter, maintenance man, machinists, and hardware retail merchandiser.

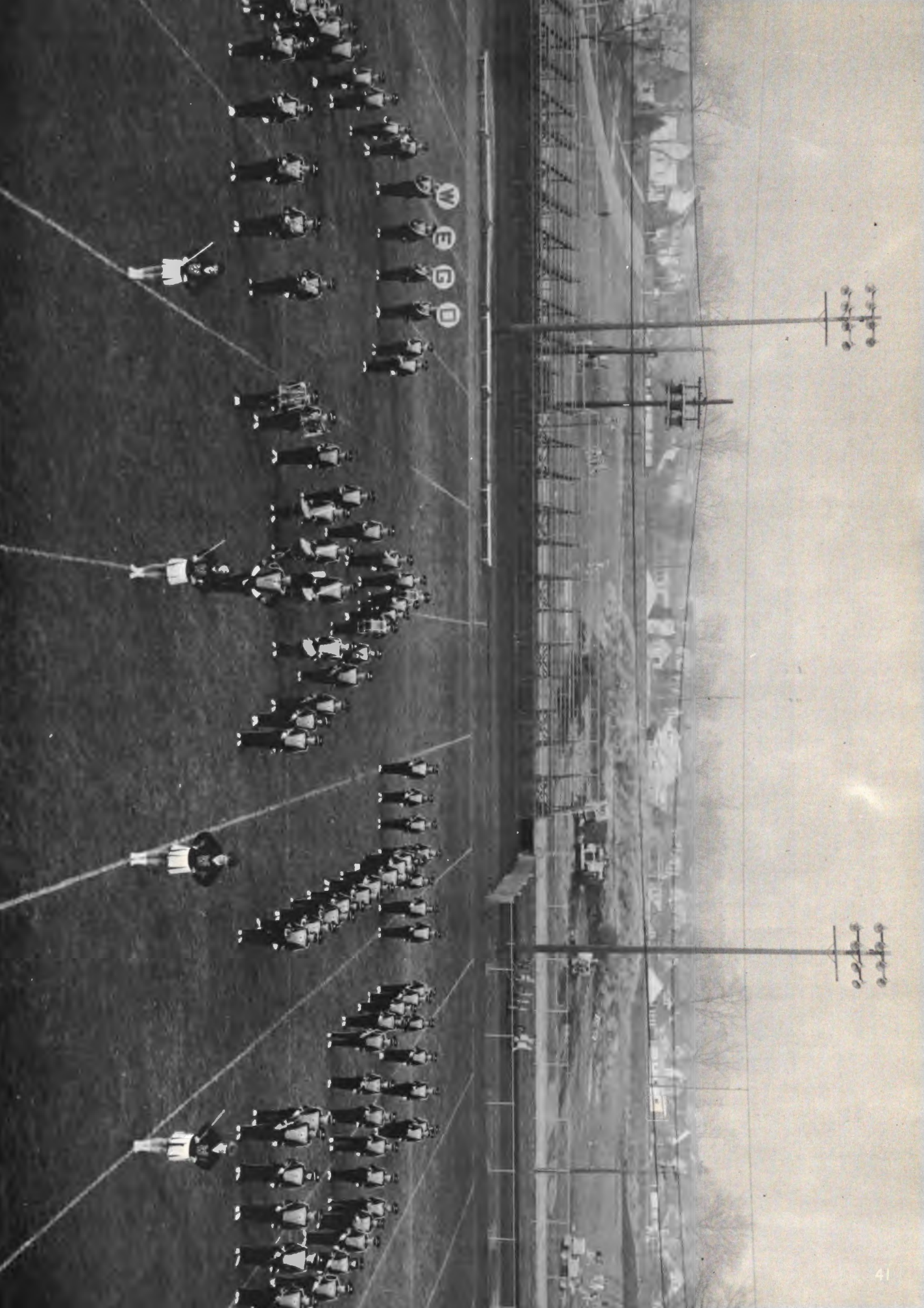

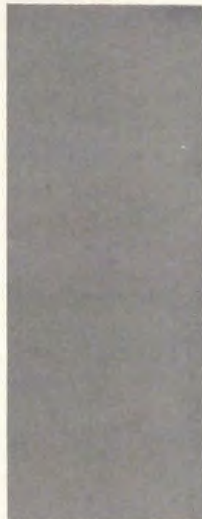


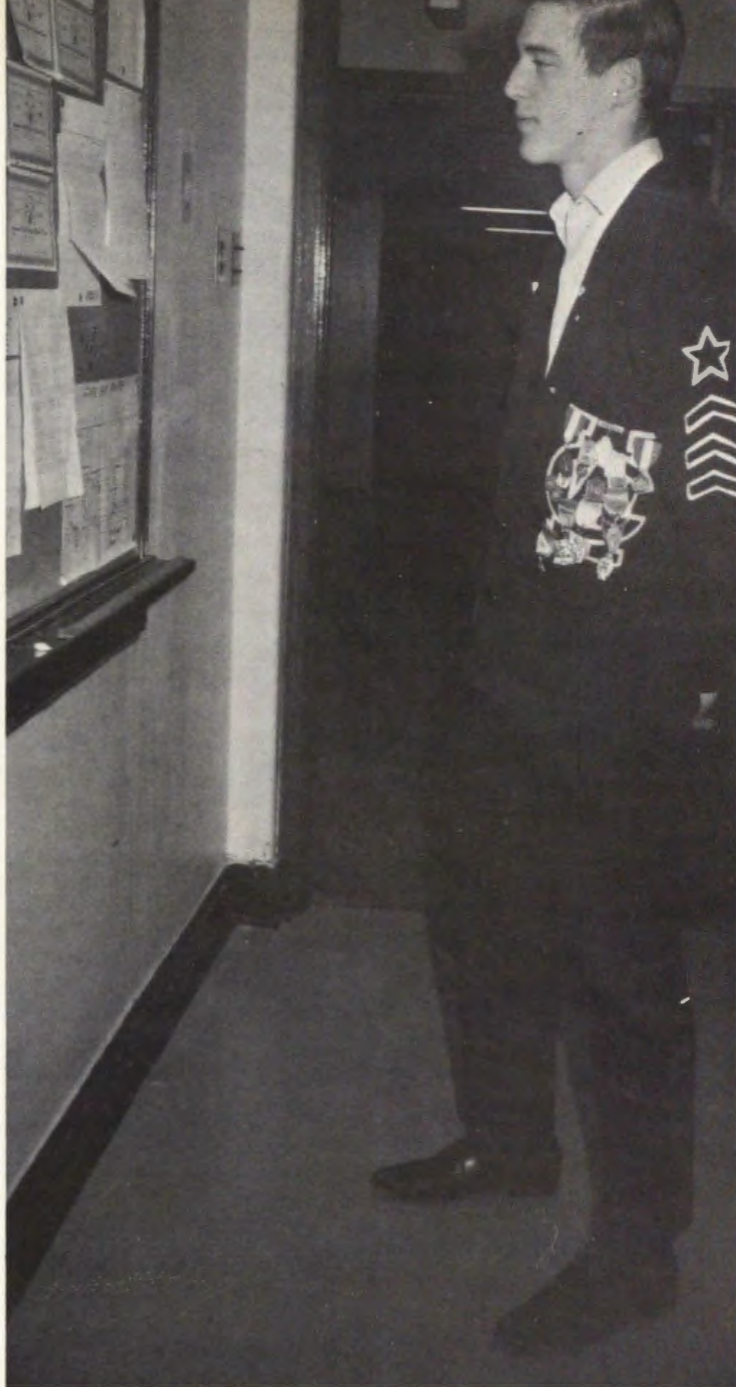

Our first homecoming float, a large pink elephant built to the theme of "Make 'Em Blush," was our first group accomplishment. After winning third place in the float competition, we were no longer last place freshmen. Every active Senior, including our class officers—President Jim Siekmann, Vice-President Buz Prescott, Secretary Sandy Bennett, and Treasurer Bob Weinbauer—was proud of our masterpiece homecoming float, "Trix Are for Cats," which won second place in the competition. 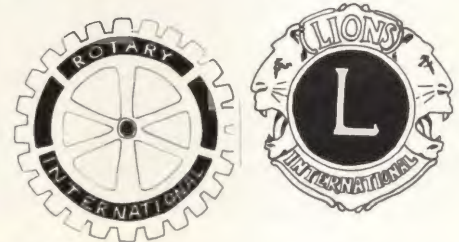
