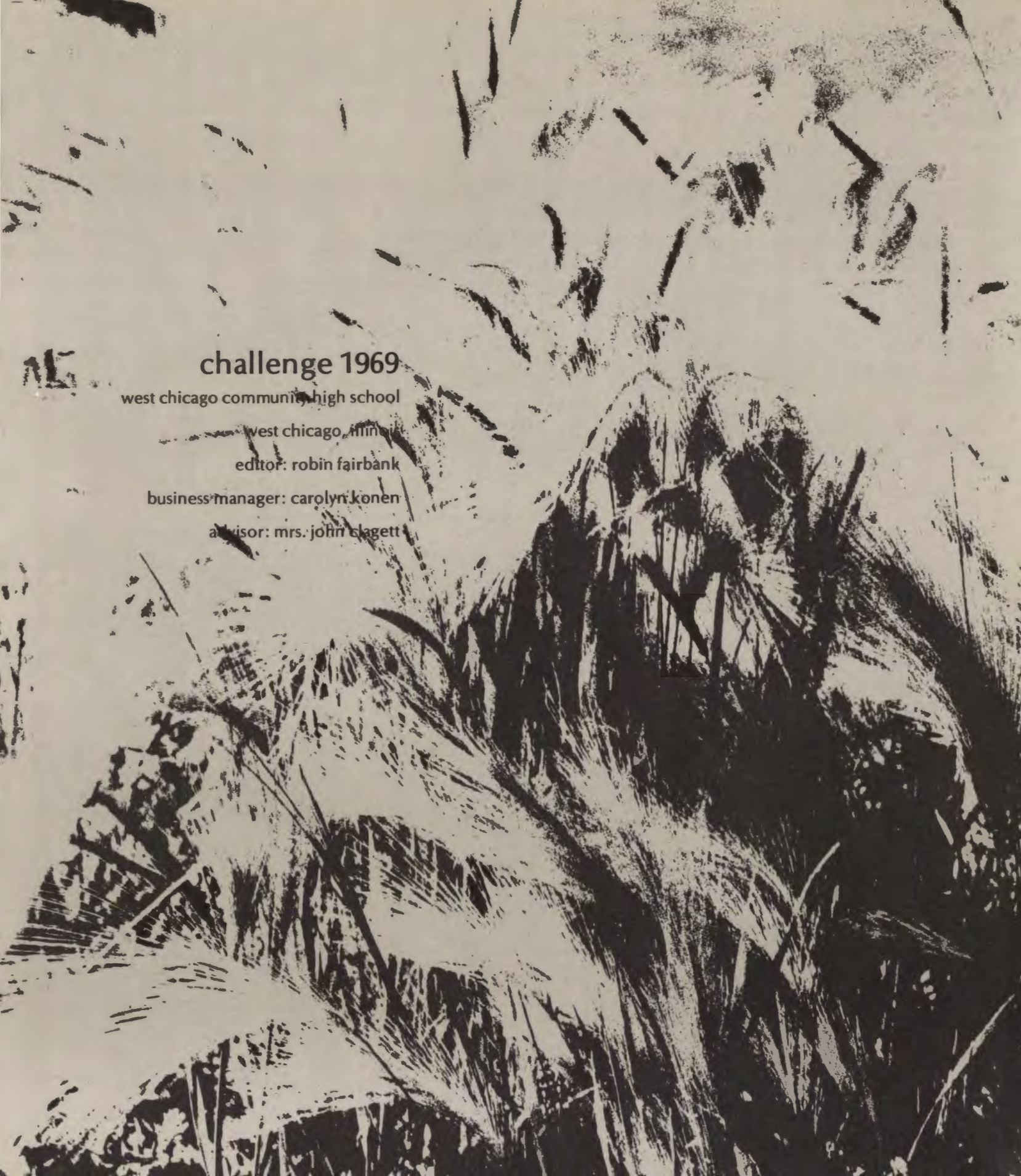

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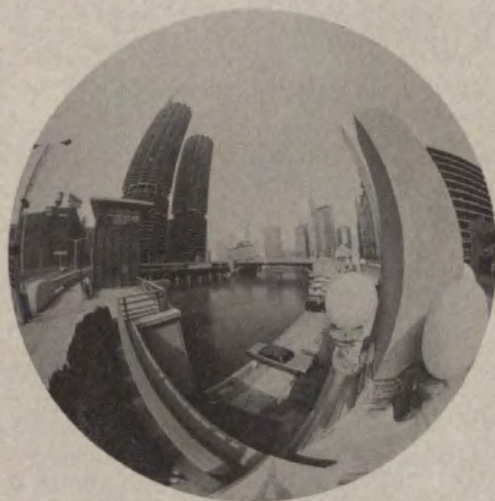

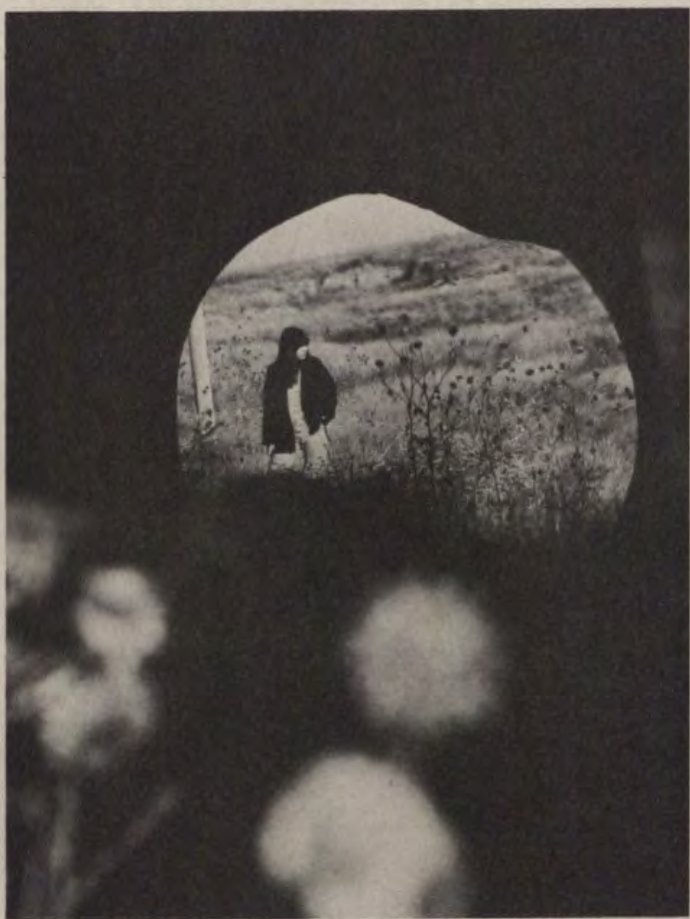

The parade wound its way to the downtown section of West Chicago.

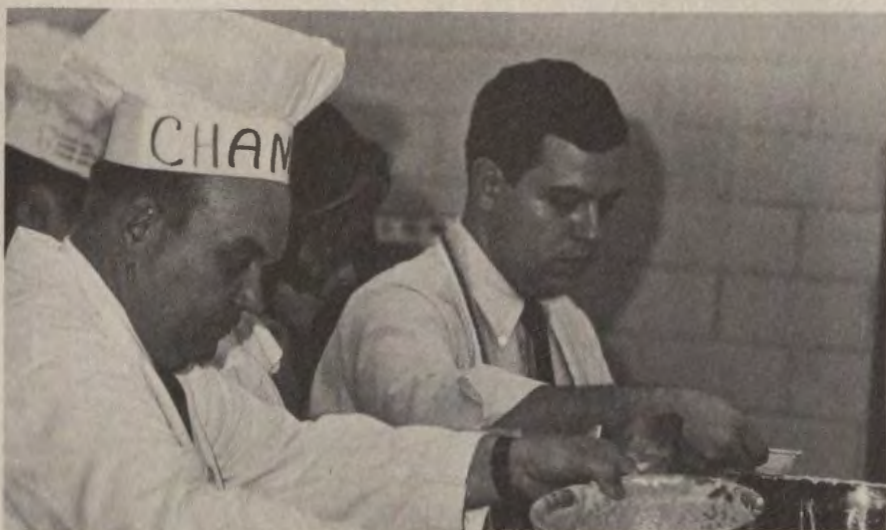

Patricia Kuhl reigns as 1969 Wrestling Queen.

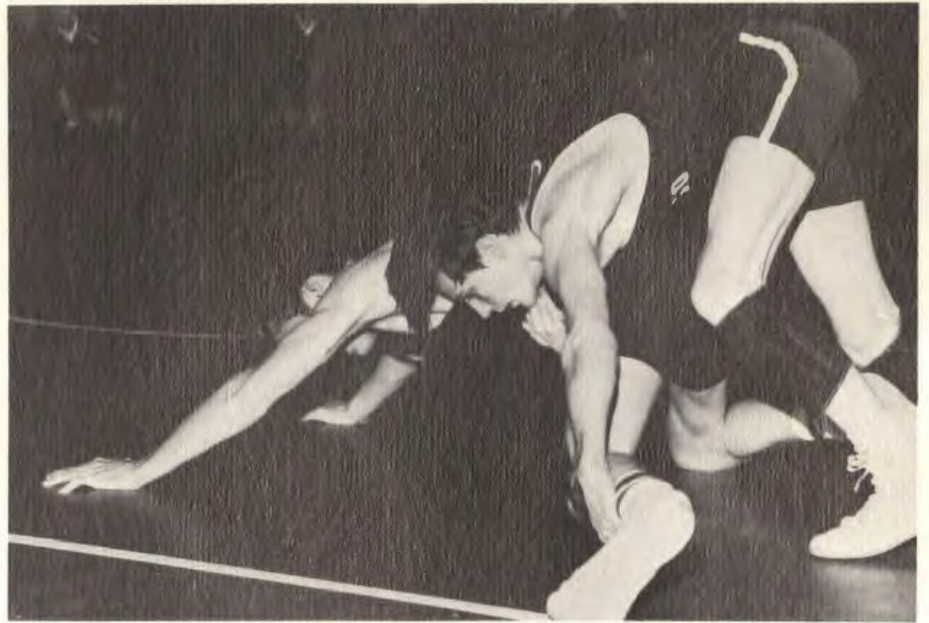

The 1968 fall season was the setting for the development of a relatively new concept in institutional functioning. Modular scheduling is now a program employed on many college campuses. This method has recently been considered and applied to many high schools.

Under this program students would attend a class, which would last approximately an hour and a half, three days a week. The other two days would be spent attending lectures or participating in discussion groups. The students would have more free time and the choice of attending class would be theirs.

Better facilities would be made available — larger classrooms, better equipment and improved study materials. Reference libraries for each subject would be equipped with tape recordings, records and visual aids. Modular scheduling is still in the developmental stages. Before this program can go into effect many problems will have to be dealt with — specifically the adopting of the physical plant to this system. The administration is currently working on these problems and striving for a feasible solution.

At the beginning of February, 1969, a tax referendum was proposed, voted upon by the citizens of West Chicago, and soundly defeated. Because of this, school spending had to be drastically reduced. Proposed cuts were the musical, yearbook, newspaper, underclassmen sports and class officers. The modular scheduling idea described above has been abandoned for the present time due to lack of funds. As of this writing no school activities have been omitted from next year's program but the threat of activities reduction still remains. June 13, 1969.
