Despite the cutbacks in the school budget, Homecoming Week remained intact thanks to the efforts of the parent-student board and the enthusiasm of the student body. To help boost spirits, this year's theme was cartoon comics.

Each day of the week had special activities planned. On Monday, people in such diverse groups as Pep Club and Snappy Club participated in Poster Day. On Tuesday, the hazards of eating faculty-cooked pancakes, like last year, were avoided when Stan's Bakery contributed sweet rolls for the Pep Breakfast. Wednesday was Slave Day and Dress-Up Day. Although boys dressed as cartoon characters could enslave any girl who had purchased a slave tag, many of the slave-girls wandered masterless unless their steady boyfriends came in costume. West Chicago came close to becoming a tribal village with Thursday night's snake dance through town, a pow-wow circle on Main Street, and the voodoo torture of a Geneva Viking effigy in the bonfire.

Friday's Coronation ceremonies saw bearded Paul Huber, Senior Class President, crown Debbie Hall Homecoming Queen. The members of her court were Kathy Kyger, Cindy Tinnes, Marilyn Cole, and Jackie Bender. The traditional parade with class floats was replaced by a massive fair-weather

turnout for the first annual Volkswagon Bug Races. The faculty and the four classes each had their own special racing Volkswagon with crews of two boys, two girls, and a driver. The faculty decided to push their car backwards in the race so they wouldn't get nosed out at the finish line. Even though the "driving" Mr. McNamara had a good rear view, they were behind from the start, and, to avoid stepping on any toes, ended up stuck in the middle of the road. Meanwhile the sophomores rolled over opposition in every heat to become the grand champion racers.

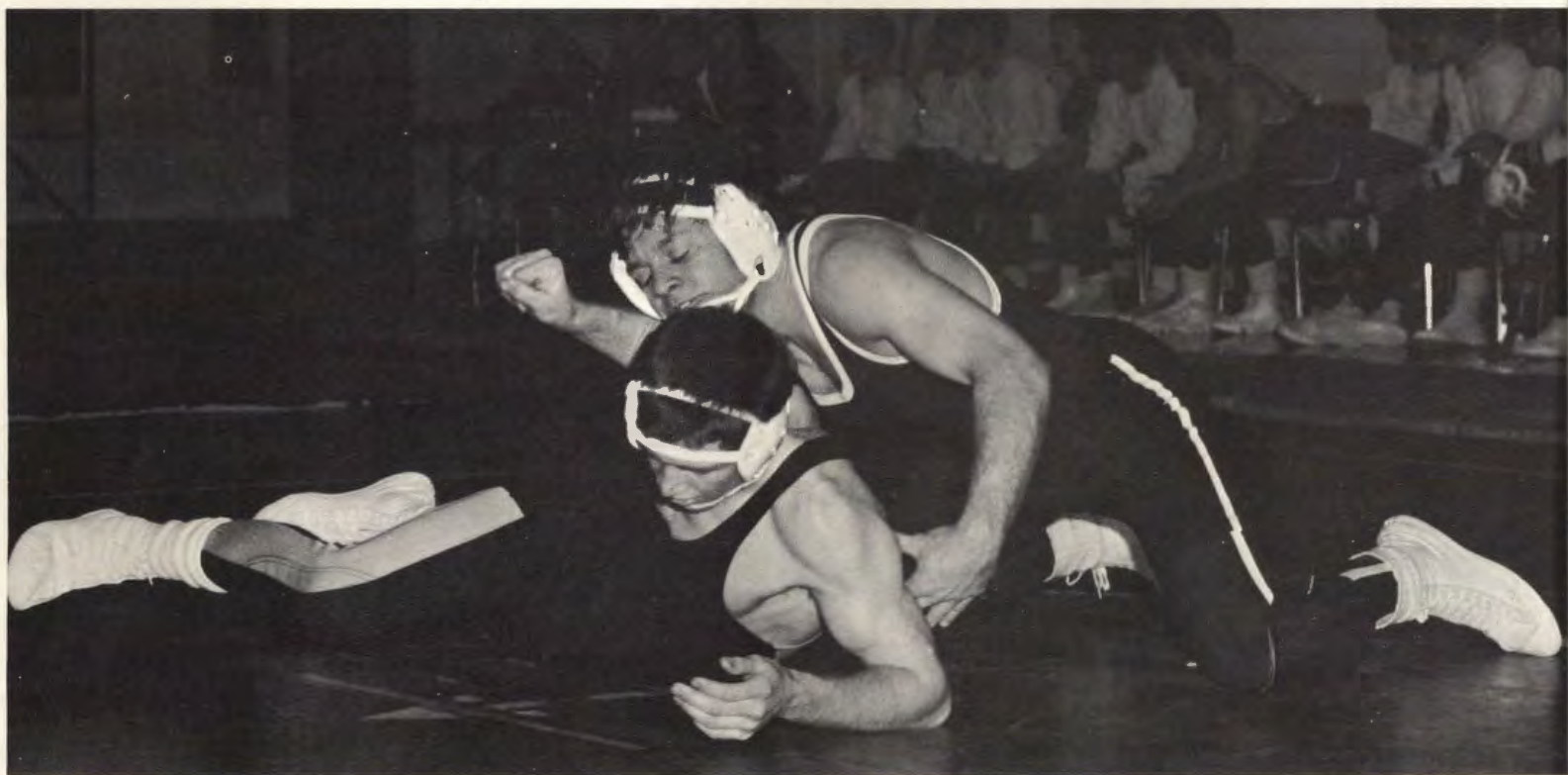


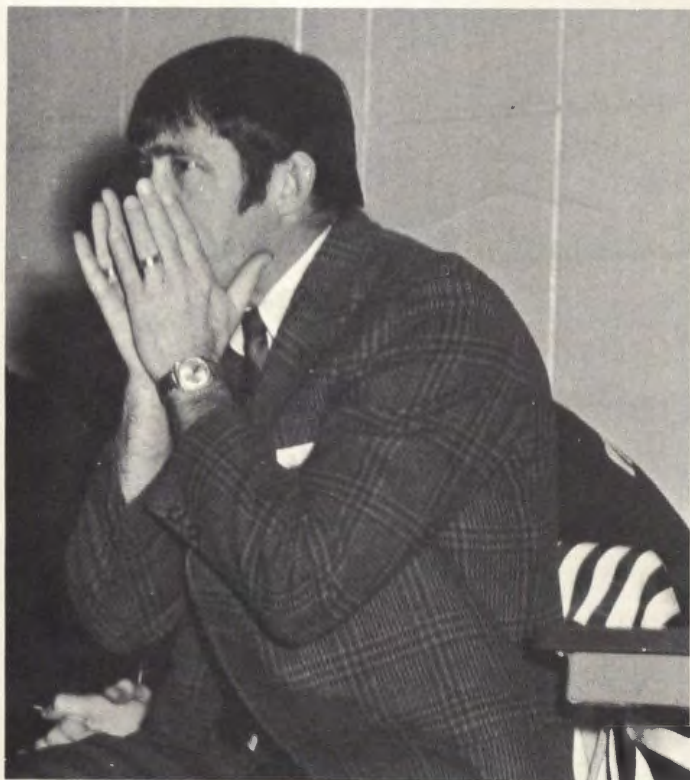
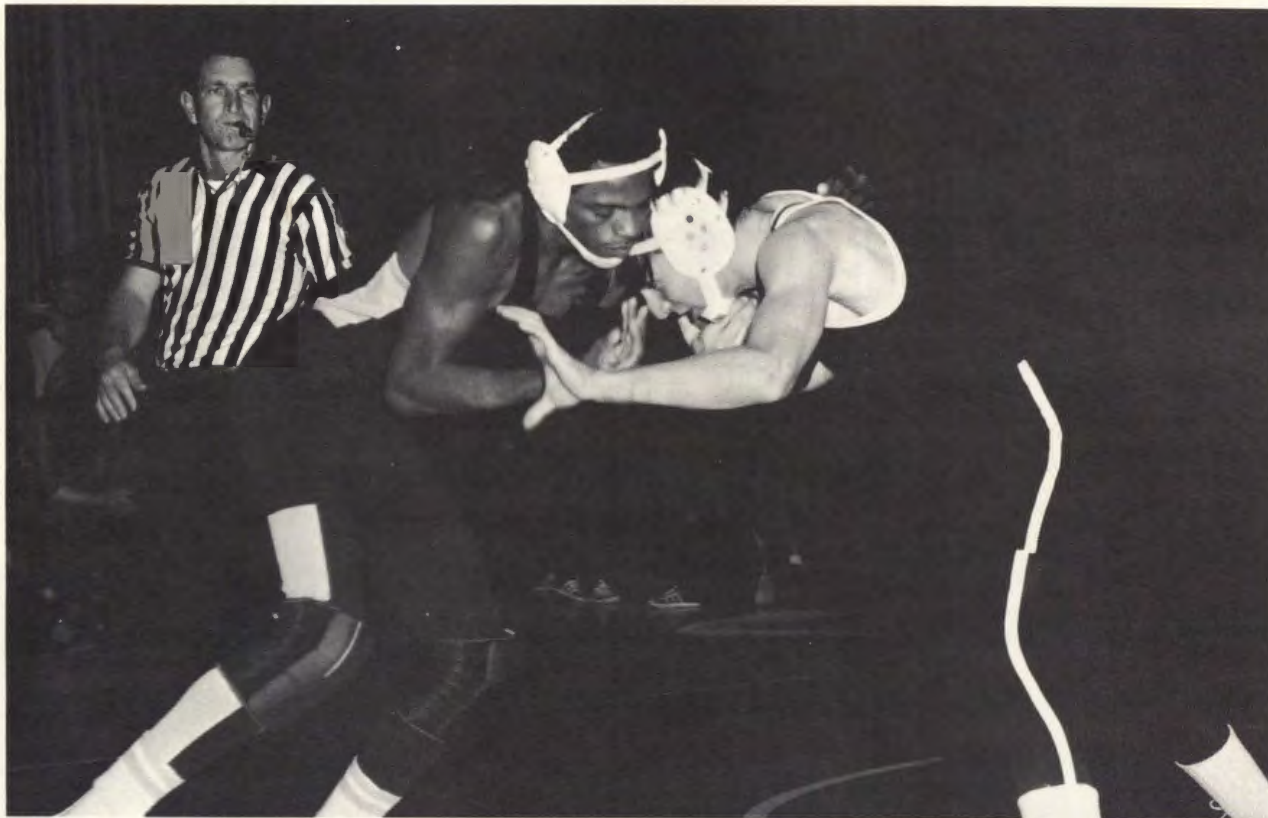


Matmen Score Victories

Both Varsity and Sophomore Wrestling Squads started the season with victories over St. Francis. The Varsity with 39 to 13 and the Sophomores 31 to 11. From there the Sophomores continued to win seven more meets, making their final season record eight wins and six losses. The squad was third in the Naperville Holiday Tournament in which there were a total of eight squads participating. They also received the second place trophy in the Little Seven Conference Meet.

The Varsity season record was five wins, eight losses, and one tie. They placed third in the Conference Tournament and fourth in the District Tournament. In the Conference Tournament Al Kowalewski placed fourth, Buzz Dempsey and Randy Gibson both were third, the trio of Dave Hensel, Pete Dombroski and Tim Truitt all were second. Ed Thompson at 185 pounds made a first. In the District Conference Al and Tim placed fourth, Dave was third. Pete and Ed both had a first. Pete and Ed were defeated one step before they went Down State by a judges decision. Ed was selected as the most valuable player and Bill Weyrauch was the most improved on the team.





Students Support Activities Through Sales

The many extra-curricular clubs of our school used a variety of sales and services to support their activities. At the beginning of the school year, the entire student body helped the magazine drive raise nearly a thousand dollars. This money went to the Co-curricular Board, which used it to pay for the Marching Band, Freshmen Class Advisor, Student Council Advisor, the All-School Play, the Musical, and the Prom.

IRO, the Language Clubs, National Honor Society, Thespians, and Varsity Club sold refreshments at the football and basketball games. During Homecoming Week, Chess Club sold

popcorn at lunch periods. Senior Girls' Dance Production Class sold pickles and "I Hate Boys" stickers to pay for the costumes and sets in their show. Student Council sold AFS shares to support our foreign student program. Other money-making campaigns included Pep Club's school pennant sale, NHS's shoe shine, and the language clubs' bake sales.

For the first time our school could not fund or sponsor a regular school paper, so independent students, organized under Snappy Club, published and sold the **New Paper** to inform and entertain student readers.

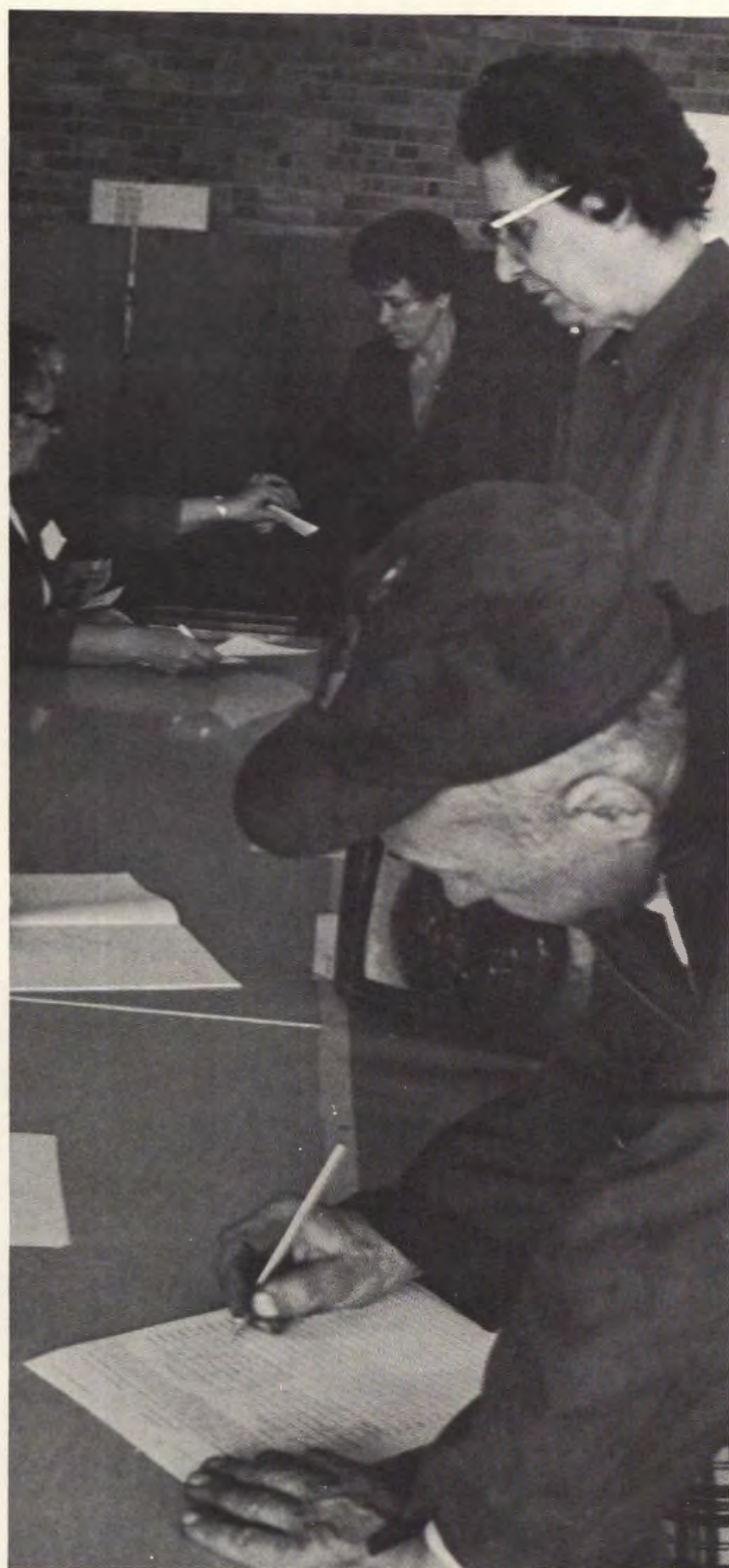




S.O.S. Succeeds in Saving Our School

S.O.S. (Save Our School) was organized in January, 1970 under the leadership of Mr. George Strecker, Mr. Stephen Arnold, and Mr. Dean Burgess. Over 150 students joined the organization, and with the efforts of student precinct chairmen and teachers, a street assignment was given to each member of S.O.S. Students distributed information sheets, registration instructions, and urged homeowners to vote "yes" on the referendum. A parade was organized for Saturday, January 17, and over 200 placard-bearing students marched despite cold weather and a snowstorm. Posters were printed and placed in stores around town the weekend before voting day. These combined efforts surely helped the passage of the referendum on January 27 by a narrow margin of 125 votes.





Exchange Students Henry, Kris, and Taeko

Our foreign students this year are Henry Tod and Kerstin (Kris) Moren of Sweden and Taeko Kanno of Japan. All arrived in the U.S. last summer and will leave in June but will receive no credit in school for their year abroad. Kris and Henry spent their entire year at our school; Taeko is a transfer student from Park Forest, Illinois.

Henry Tod, 18, comes from Hovas, a town of 12,000. His father owns and operates a paper-products plant and his mother is an X-ray technician. He has two sisters: Karin, 21, and Elizabeth, 13. Henry plans to become a lawyer, so he has one year left of "gymnasium" (high school), five years of college, and five years in law court to look forward to before he will be a member of the bar. Henry loves to travel, and has been to Tangier, Morocco; Paris, France; and Spain before coming to the U.S. He enjoys water sports, the theater, music and reading in his spare time. Henry was most impressed by the "bigness of things" in America, the quick travel by jet from coast to coast, and television commercials.

Kerstin (Kris) Moren, 17, comes from Saltsjobaden: a town of 7,000; twelve miles east of Stockholm. Her father is technical manager of a daily newspaper in Stockholm and he commutes daily in his Mercedes-Benz. Her mother is a housewife and a free-lance writer. Kris has three younger brothers: John, 13, Nils, 11, and Henrik, 7. She is undecided about her future

but will finish "gymnasium" in two years. Kris enjoys swimming, skiing, jazz dancing, sewing, and reading. Kris, like Henry, was impressed by the friendliness of Americans and misses the fresh ocean fish back home. Both Kris and Henry are Lutheran, as are most Swedes.

Taeko Kanno, 18, comes from Sendai, a city of 500,000. Her father owns a hardware store and her mother is strictly a housewife, although their family does have a full-time maid. She has one brother: Akira, 16, and her grandfather also lives in the home. Taeko wants to be an interior decorator after she finishes a four-year college. She enjoys watching "Bewitched" and "Mission Impossible" on Japanese television, plus American films like **Sound of Music**. She is impressed by the "wide open spaces" of America because Japan is too crowded, and she likes getting away from the 8:00 curfew in her town and the uniforms she must wear to her private high school. She misses her regular diet of raw fish, octopus, sea weed, squid, snake, eel, and Italian food. Taeko wants to see Expo 70 when she returns to Japan this summer.

All three students say there is much more homework in American schools, but the subject matter is not as difficult once the language barrier is conquered. Kris and Henry say "Hej-hejda" (hello-goodbye) and Taeko says "Sayonara."

Pep Club Presents "Chirp"

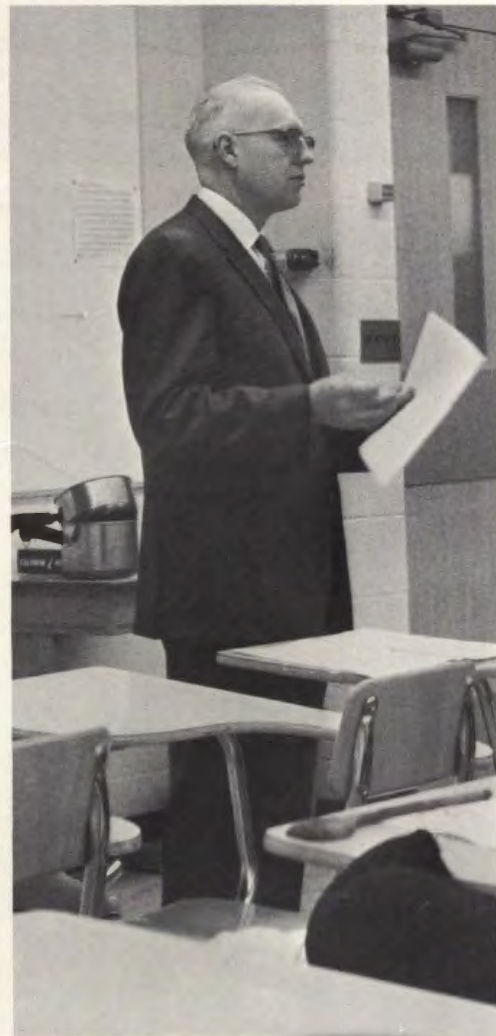

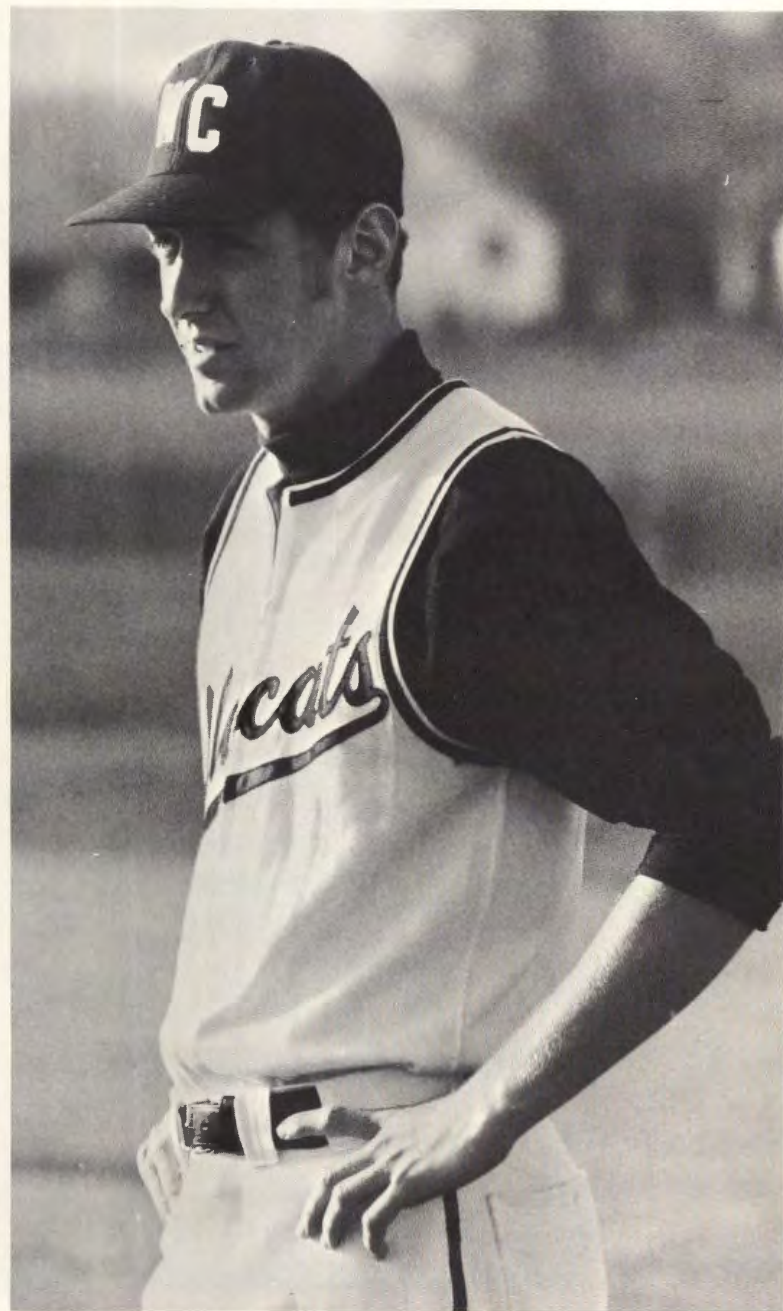

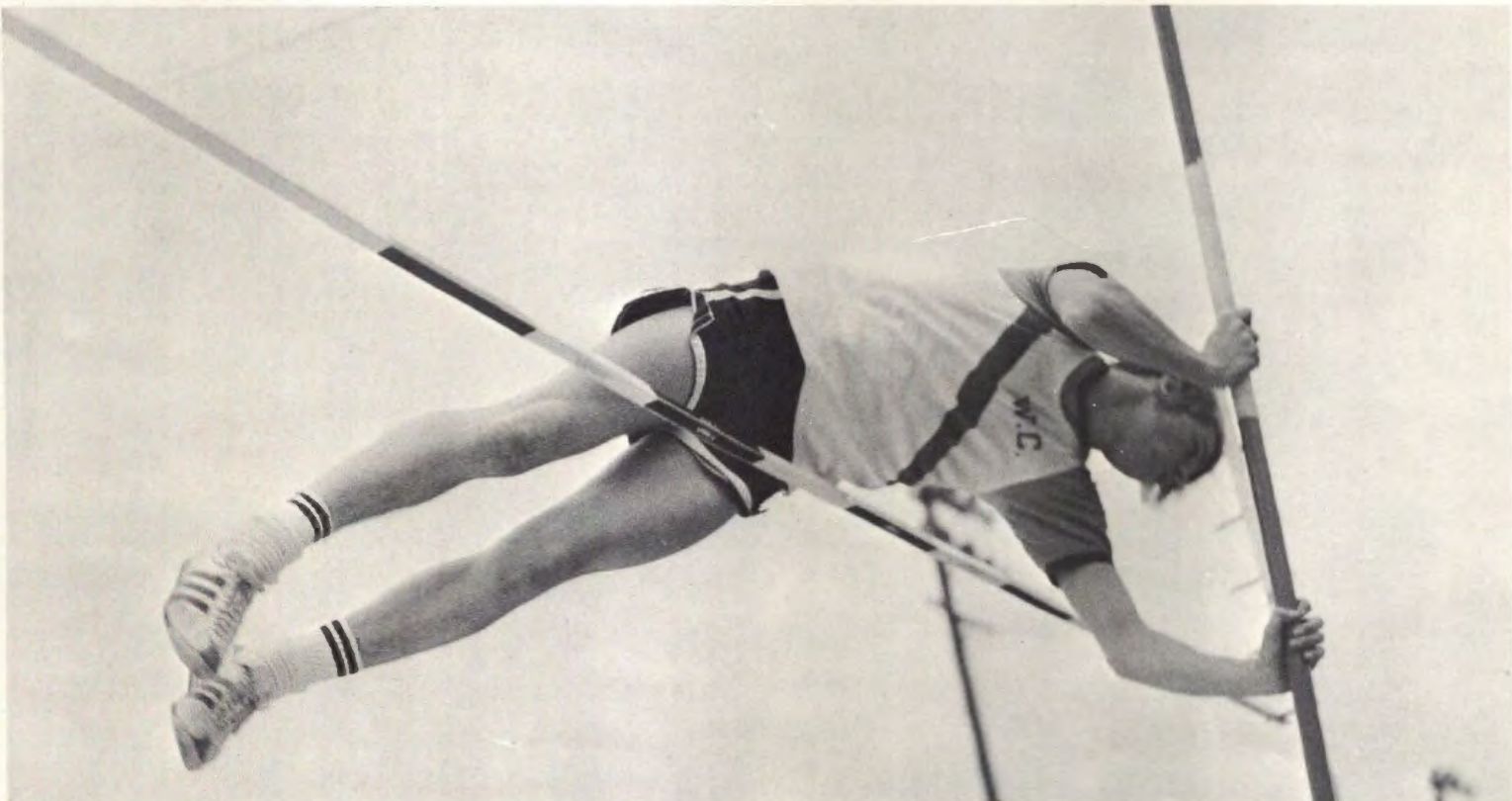

Record Breaking Year For Cindermen

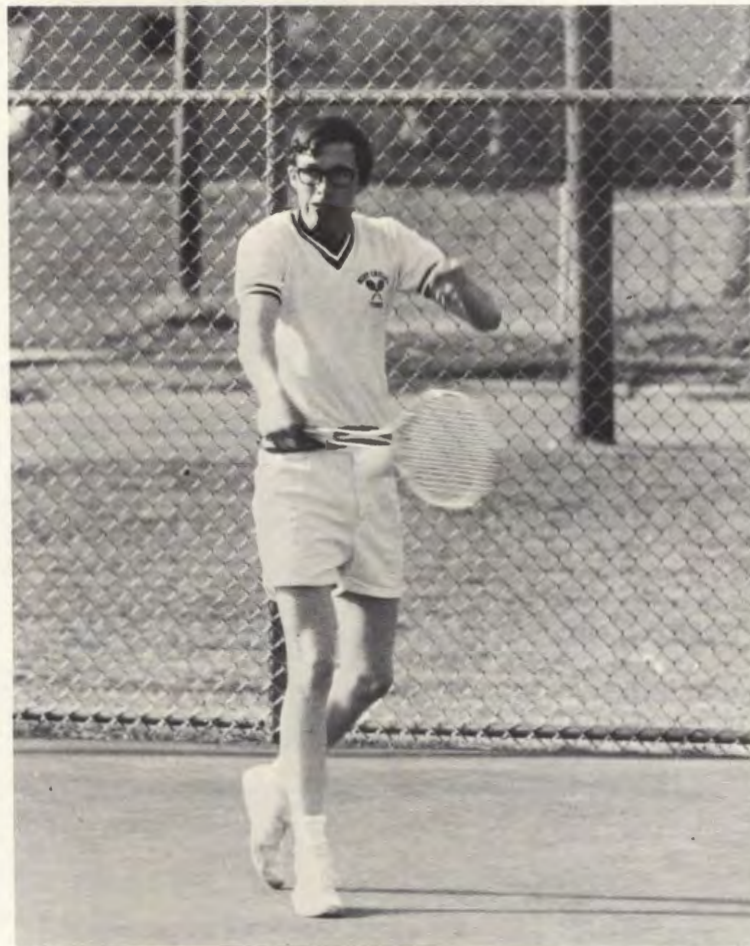

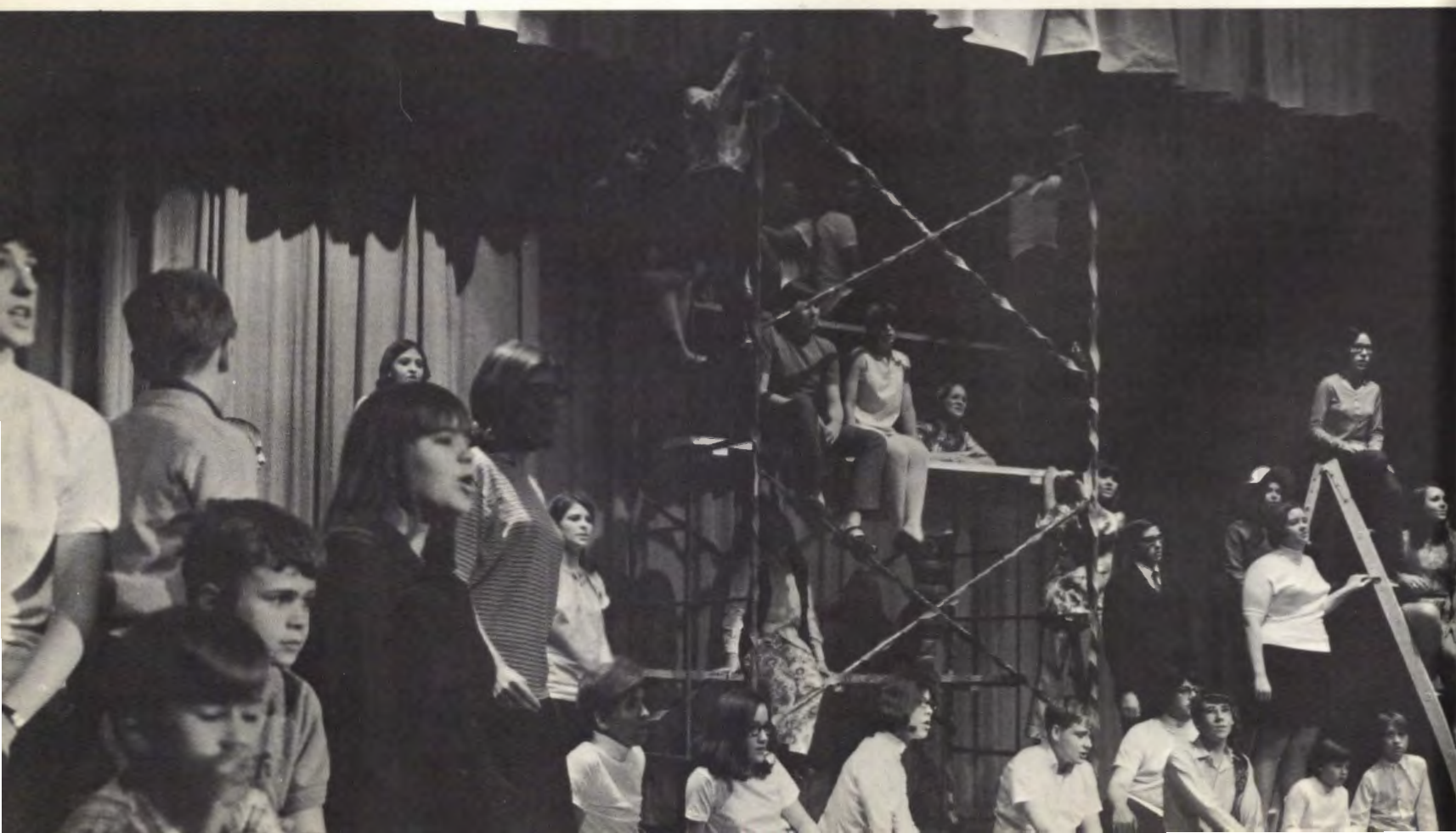




Don't Look Back: the Performance

Graduation 1970

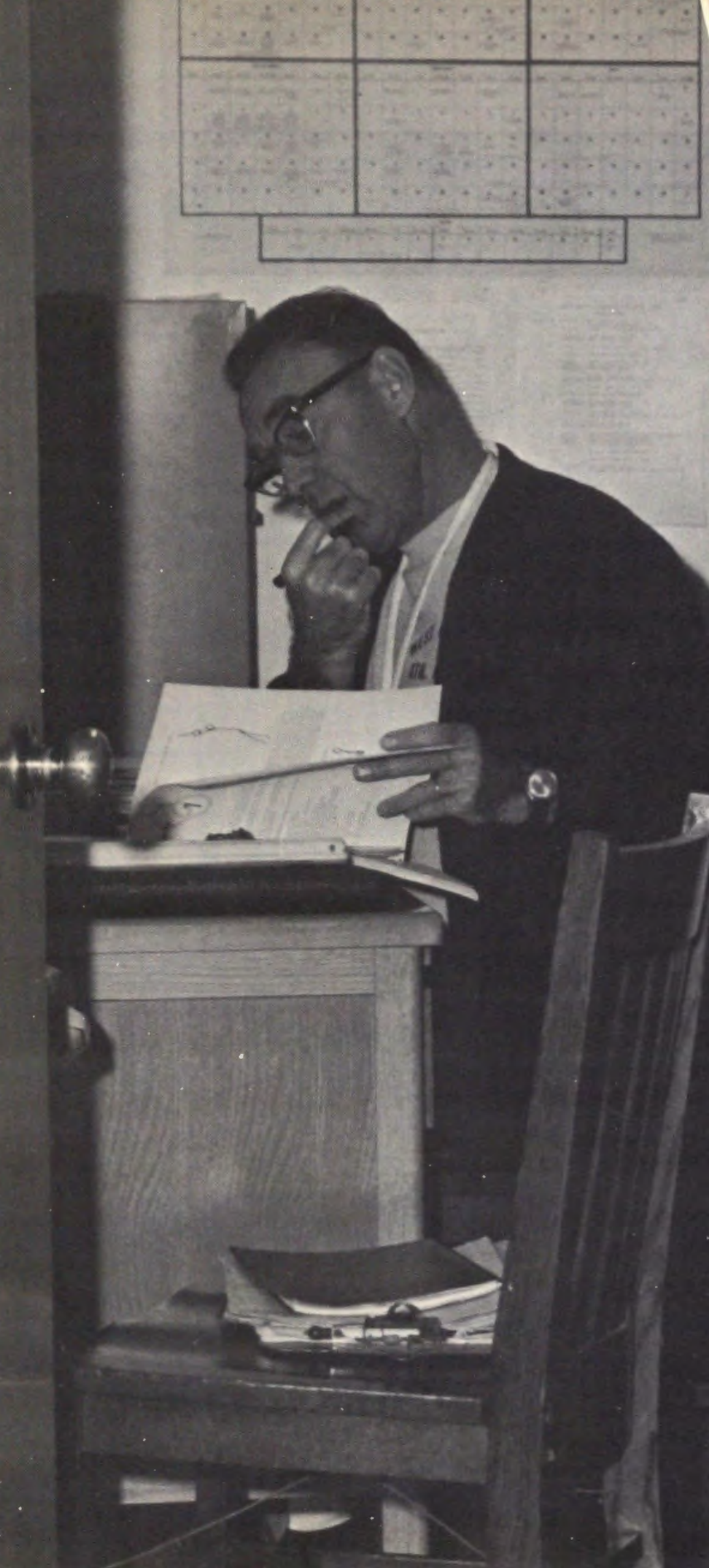

Sandra Petlon, Stephen Poirier, and Lori Schuett were Valedictorians of the graduating class of 1970.

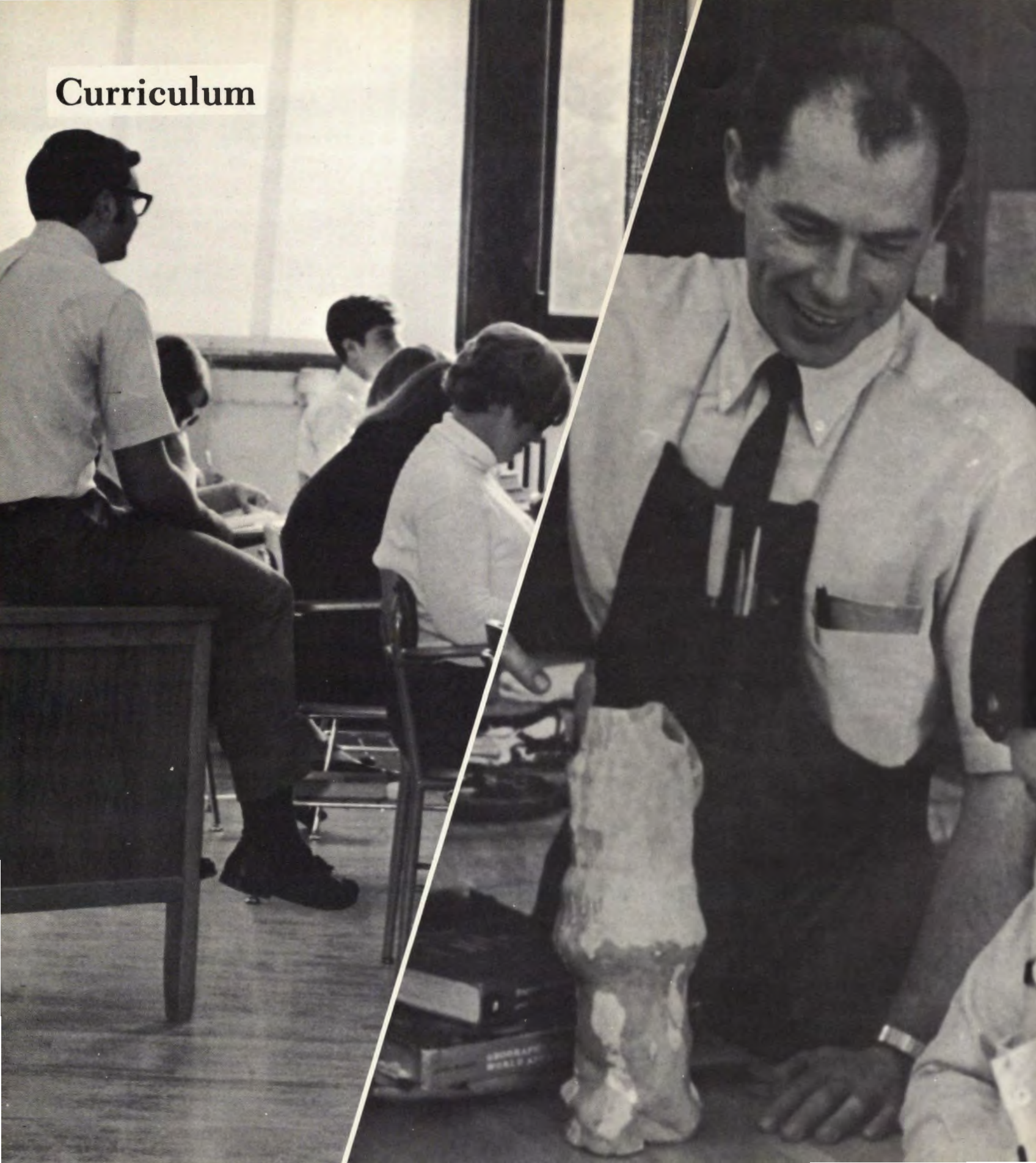
